Research problem: understanding the biographical careers of low skilled women involved in prostitution

- A. Rise of the sex industry in China and a prohibiting legislation
- First paradox: prostitution is widely on the rise in China although a new legislation that represses fiercely the phenomenon has been reinforced in through the 1990's.
- Context: upheaval on the labour markets, dismantling of social protection and rise of inequalities
 - > emergence of a sex market

Research problem: understanding the biographical careers of low skilled women involved in prostitution

- B. Discriminations, resistance and subjectivity
- The sex market as an option to resist to discriminations on the labour market and socio-economic marginalisation
- But prostitution goes with more discriminations and another form of marginalisation

Research problem: understanding the biographical careers of low skilled women involved in prostitution

- C. Assumptions and first findings
- Prostitution in the city and family life in the village: 2 highly disconnected social spaces
- A legitimate space and a deviant one: different amount of social legitimacy
- Prostitution as an active strategy to resist to inequalities suffered in the first space: women enter the prostitution space so as to acquire new resources there that they will use to improve their situation in the first space

Methodological cosmopolitanism and research on prostitution

- Paola Tabet : « continuum of sexual-economic exchanges » : from free marriage to prostitution
- Viviana Zelizer : cultural taboo of money and feelings trade
- > "prostitution" as the result of a process of negative labelling of a relation, that occurs when the trading between sex and money is explicit
